COMPLETE TOURNAMENT RULES ON BACK

Singles Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. Participation

- a. Participation is limited to members of USBC bowling in a York Adams certified youth league.
- b. Coaches are responsible for verification of USBC membership and must sign the entry form.
- c. USBC tournament rules and regulations will govern this tournament.
- d. Bowlers may enter as often as they wish. (See Award rule 5-f) Walk-ins will be permitted. **Entries postmarked or received after the deadline date will be considered a walk-in and will be charged \$25.00.** PA State Dress code (bowlpa.com) will be in effect. No hats.
- e. No electronic devices may be used during tournament play.

2. Tournament Divisions

- a. Tournament divisions are as follows for both Boys and Girls:
 - i. U10 – 9 and under
 - ii. U12 – 10-11
 - iii. U14 – 12-13
 - iv. U16 - 14-15
 - v. U18 - 16-17
 - vi. Bowler's age as of August 1, 2025 will determine division.

3. Averages

- a. Each entrant shall use his/her highest average, minimum of 12 games, as of February 28, 2026. Bowlers who do not have an established average as of this date shall bowl scratch.
- b. Bowlers are responsible for using correct averages; falsification of average will result in disqualification.
- c. **Coaches shall forward to the tournament director an alphabetical average sheet for the 25 - 26 season for the week ending February 28, 2026 for the purpose of verifying averages..**

4. Handicap

- a. Handicap shall be computed as follows:
- b. U10 and U12 90% of 200, U14 90% of 220, U16 and U18 90% of 240

5. Scholarships and Awards

- a. **First place guaranteed in all divisions. Second place awarded with a minimum of five in each division.**
 - i. U10 – 1st place \$200
 - ii. U12 – 1st place \$400 2nd place \$200
 - iii. U14 – 1st place \$600 2nd place \$300
 - iv. U16– 1st place \$800 2nd place \$400
 - v. U18– 1st place \$1000 2nd place \$500
 - vi. Highest Scratch Score, regardless of division: \$500
 - b. Scholarships awarded to both boys and girls in each division, per the York-Adams USBC scholarship policy. All scholarships are placed in SMART account 13062.
 - c. Awards ratio will be 1 out of 8 or major portion thereof.
 - d. In case of tie, duplicate awards will be given. A tie for first in any division regarding scholarship monies in the division will be paid equally. A tie for 2nd place in any division shall be paid equally.
 - e. All awards fees collected will be returned in the way of awards
6. In no case shall the same individual place more than once in the awards list. The scratch scholarship winner may not be the winner of any other scholarship, however, they may be the winner of any other award.

7. General

- a. Lanes will be dressed once per tournament day.
- b. If not contacted by the tournament director, 1st squad time and date selected will be the time you bowl.
- c. **There will be no substitutes allowed for bowlers unless approved by the bowler or bowler's coach.** If at a later date the original entrant decides to bowl, a walk-in fee will be charged.
- d. Bowlers shall report to the tournament one-half hour prior to squad time for lane assignment.
- e. Any appeal or protest must be filed in accordance with USBC tournament rules and regulations.
- f. Bowlers must present their current USBC card or online proof of membership.
- g. Coaches must forward average verification and payments with entries! Entries must be postmarked no later than **March 5, 2026. Entries postmarked or received after the deadline date will be charged a \$5.00 late fee per entry. No Exceptions!**
